# Notas de Programa

## Programme Notes

Quis desta forma perpetuar uma aliança entre o passado e o presente. Quis fugir um pouco ao caminho fácil e tentador de peças mais comerciais, artificiais e sem o sabor português das azeitonas e pão. Lembro-me de que ao assistir a gravações dos famosos concursos de bandas japonesas uma coisa me chamou a atenção. No meio de tantas obras de elevado nível técnico e musical, as peças obrigatórias eram sempre em forma de marcha, em ritmo de marcha, algo que estará para sempre associado à génese das bandas. Logo, o meu ponto de partida foi a tradicional “marcha de concerto”. Foi a isso que me propus nas pautas seguintes, contudo, tentei ir mais longe, simulando mesmo um pouco de uma habitual romaria e festa de banda, descrevendo musicalmente alguns momentos. Por isso, chamei ao conjunto dos dois andamentos “Marchas de Arraial”.

O 1º andamento, é como o nome indica uma procissão. Não há festa sem procissão e é neste momento que as gentes da terra vêem a banda. Repararam na farda, comentam os músicos, imitam os instrumentos...

Esta é no alcatrão, num ambiente moderno, quente, a torrar ao sol. Marca a caixa, o bombo avisa, já há notas trocadas, ninguém nota, ninguém leva a mal. A caminhada é sofrida e não há água nem imperial. Ouvem-se os sinos da igreja, atenção ao bombo que vai dizer para parar. O 2º andamento é já depois de um tempo de distração. Já tocou a fanfarra, agora é a banda que no coreto vai tocar a sua marcha. Ritmos folclóricos e harmonia popular que modula como se quisesse enriquecer a sua cor. Os instrumentos são outros, os mais novos estudam mais, “a marcha tem compasso” lá diz o Zé com a bifana e o tinto na mão, “mas lembra-me que é diferente da dos outros anos”.

A presente obra foi escrita durante o Verão de 2008. Esta partitura é resultado de uma revisão em Abril de 2010 para a Banda Sinfónica da Guarda Nacional Republicana a pedido do seu Chefe, Capitão João Cerqueira.

**I wanted to perpetuate an alliance between the past and the present. I wanted to get away from an easy and tempting path, the commercial and artificial way that is far beyond the Portuguese traditional flavor of codfish, olives and bread. I remember that when I was watching recordings of the famous Japanese bands contests one peculiar thing caught my attention. required pieces were always in the form of a march, March rhythms, something that will forever be associated with the bands genesis. Therefore, my starting point for this work was the traditional "Concert March." That was what I set out in the following score, however, I tried to go further. Wow? Simulating the habitual pilgrimage and a summer festivity. This set of two movements is called " Marchas de Arraial" (Folk Marches).**

**The 1st movement, as the name indicates is a procession. In the Portuguese festive tradition, bands accompanying the priest at a religious procession. There is no summer party without procession and is at this time that the villagers really see the band, repair at their uniforms, do comments on the musicians, and imitate their instruments.**

**This is on an asphalted, tarmac road, in a modern and really hot environment; the band is roasting in the sun heat. The snare drum is marking the beat, the bass drum gives the warning signal, there are already wrong notes but no one notices. This walk is painful and there is no water (or cold beer). We hear the church bells. Pay attention, the bass drum will tell us when to stop.**

**The 2nd movement is after a pause for distraction. The fanfare plays first and then the band will play its march on the coreto (traditional bandstand). There are other instruments, the younger band members study more, "the march has rhythm "says Joe with his red wine glass in the hand, but " it's a different march form the past years".**

**This work was written during the summer of 2008. This score is the result of a review in April 2010 for the Banda Sinfónica da Guarda Nacional Republicana, GNR (Symphonic National Guard Band) at the request of his conductor, Captain João Afonso Cerqueira.**
